- 1. Contractor shall report directly to California High School Rodeo Association (CHSRA) Vice-President, Jason Dewey, State Finals Arena Director (the "Arena Director").
- 2. At least seven (14) days prior to the event Contractor shall notify CHSRA of Contractor's key management personnel (the "Stock Boss"). The Arena Director shall have the right to approve or reject Contractor's selection of Stock Boss in his sole discretion.

<u>3</u> Pickup Men

- 3. All livestock shall meet the current NHSRA Livestock Requirements for each event.
- 4. At least seven (14) days prior to the event Contractor shall notify CHSRA of all subcontractors who will provide livestock for the event under this Agreement and provide the Arena Director with a written stock list of all proposed stock to be provided to the event draw. The Arena Director shall have the right to approve or reject the Contractor's selection of any and all subcontractors and shall have the right to approve or reject any and all stock identified in the written stock list, in his sole discretion.
- Contractor shall arrive at the Eastern Sierra Tri-County Fairgrounds (the "Grounds") no later than <u>6:00 p.m. Sunday,</u> June 8, 2025 (June 7, 2026). Contractor's Stock Boss shall arrive with the livestock and shall remain on grounds through the entire rodeo performance.
- 6. Contractor shall remove all livestock, vehicles and equipment from the Grounds no later than <u>5:00 p.m. Sunday, June 15,</u> <u>2025 (June 14, 2026)</u>.
- 7. Contractor shall perform its obligations under this Agreement in compliance with a NHSRA rules governing the care and treatment of livestock at NHSRA sanctioned rodeos, CHSRA's requirements for the care and treatment of livestock set forth in the specific contract conditions ("Contract Conditions") attached hereto, and in compliance with all federal, state, and local laws and regulations.

- 8. Contractor shall be responsible for livestock transportation expenses.
- 9. Contractor shall be solely responsible for the health, condition and welfare of all livestock provided by Contractor and its subcontractors under this Agreement or otherwise brought upon the Grounds.
 - a. Contractor shall supply healthy, usable stock in the numbers above.
 - b. Contractor shall supply all feed for livestock, and shall be responsible for feeding and watering all livestock while on the Grounds.
 - c. CHSRA veterinarians shall have complete and unrestricted access to all livestock located on the grounds or used in any event in the rodeo. Contractor hereby consents to veterinary treatment of any injured animals as may be directed by CHSRA veterinarians.
- 10. Contractor specifically agrees to indemnify and hold CHSRA harmless as set forth in the Contract Conditions attached hereto.
- 11. Contractor, and any subcontractor providing livestock under this Agreement, shall maintain, at its expense, liability insurance satisfying all insurance requirements set forth in the Contract Conditions attached hereto.
- 12. Contractor agrees that time is of the essence in the performance of its obligations under this Agreement.
- 13. All persons working in Contractor's business operations (including all employees of subcontractors) are under Contractors sole direction and control. Contractor shall bear the risk of loss of its livestock, vehicles and equipment used by it in its business operations.
- 14. All roping calves will be roped and tied and adequately trained prior to the event, off the Grounds.
- 15. All steer wrestling steers will be thrown and adequately trained prior to the event, off the Grounds.
- 16. All livestock will be worked through chutes and exit gates in arena on Monday, June 7, 2025 (June 8, 2026).
- 17. In the event that Stock Contractor is unable to provide the minimum numbers of livestock meeting the requirements regarding minimum weight, breed and stock preparation/conditioning in accordance with NHSRA rules and the parameters set forth in this Agreement, the Contractor shall be fined <u>\$100.00</u> for each non-conforming animal. The Arena Director shall have the right to declare livestock as non-conforming in his sole discretion.
- 18. In the event that Stock Contactor is unable to provide the minimum numbers of healthy livestock as they are unloaded onto the grounds, the Contractor shall be fined <u>\$100.00</u> for each animal below required minimum. The minimum shall be determined each year at the March meeting of the committee, as number of contestants can vary year to year.

California High School Rodeo Association ("CHSRA") agrees to the following:

Payment for Livestock and Services as described below:

- Payment will be distributed no earlier than Saturday, June 14, 2025(June 13, 2026) at the end of the event.
- 1. CHSRA shall have exclusive control over the production and scheduling of the event.
- 2. If Contractor (or its subcontractors) fails to perform as contemplated by this Agreement, CHSRA may, in its sole discretion, terminate this Agreement at any time and pursue any appropriate remedies.
- 3. This bid is for a 2-year contract. In the event that Stock Contractor (or its subcontractors) fails to perform as contemplated by this Agreement after the first year, CHSRA has the right to terminate the agreement for the remaining year.

CONTRACT CONDITIONS

Indemnity:

To the fullest extent permitted by law, Contractor and each of its subcontractors, employees and agents shall indemnify and hold harmless the CHSRA, and the directors, officers, employees and members thereof and each of them from claims, demands, causes of actions and liabilities of every kind and nature whatsoever arising out of or in connection with Contractor's operations performed under this Agreement. This indemnification all administrative actions, enforcement actions, lawsuits, civil or criminal penalties, claims, liabilities and expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees and costs at any administrative proceedings and any court costs) on account of any violation in connection with, or as a result of performance of the obligations under this Agreement. This indemnification shall extend to claims occurring after this agreement is terminated as well as while it is in force. The indemnity shall apply regardless of any active and/or passive negligent act or omission of the CHSRA, or the Directors, Officers and members thereof and each of them or caused solely by the designs provided by such parties. The indemnity set forth in this Section shall not be limited by insurance requirements or by any other provision of the Agreement. All work covered by this Agreement done at the site or in preparing or delivering livestock, materials or equipment to the site shall be at the sole risk of the Livestock Contractor.

Insurance:

Contractor and each of its subcontractors shall maintain at all times hereunder comprehensive general liability insurance coverage, including broad form property damage, completed operations, personal injury, contractual coverage, and automobile general liability insurance providing coverage of all owned, hired and non-owned automobiles, endorsed to name both the CHSRA and Amador County Fairgrounds as additional insured, insuring against the liability of Contractor and its subcontractors arising out of and in connection with performance of its obligations under this Agreement and the use or occupancy of the Amador County Fairgrounds, with adequate coverage amounts agreed to by CHSRA, in its sole and absolute discretion. Contractor shall deliver to CHSRA a certificate or certificates evidencing the foregoing insurance at least fourteen (14) days in advance of the event or as otherwise requested. <u>CONTRACTOR IS ADDED AS NAMED INSURED FOR CONTRACTED EVENT</u> ONLY.

In addition, Contractor and its subcontractor shall maintain workers' compensation coverage sufficient to comply with all applicable laws. All insurance carried by Contractor and its subcontractors shall be primary and noncontributory with any insurance carried by CHSRA and each policy shall contain a waiver by the insurer of any right of subrogation against CHSRA, its affiliates, insurers, employees and contractors.

Disaster Clause:

Either party shall be excused for any failure to perform by such party in the performance of this agreement unavoidably caused by the act of any governmental authority, the act of any enemy, natural disasters, the elements of war, terrorism, war defense conditions, commercial impracticality, litigation, strikes, walkouts, or other causes beyond its control. Each party shall use due diligence to avoid such delay or default and to resume performance under this agreement as promptly as possible after such delay or default.

California Law:

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed and enforced in accordance with the internal laws of the State of California without reference to California's choice or law rules.
